



## **Protocols and Procedures during COVID-19 Pandemic**

1. Students should NOT attend class if:
  - He/She has travelled outside of the country within the last 14 days
  - He/She has a fever, cough or any other cold/flu symptoms
  - He/She has come into contact with anyone who has travelled outside the province within 14 days
  - He/She has come into contact with anyone who may have been exposed to Covid-19
2. In an effort to keep traffic down and minimize the risk of covid-19 transmission, we ask that parents please wait in their cars or at home, not in the lobby.
3. We kindly ask that parents take students temperatures before sending them to class to ensure they don't have a fever.
4. Students should come to class in their dance clothes ready to go to avoid changing in the washrooms.
5. Students should bring a water bottle. Each dancer needs their own as sharing water will not be permitted.
6. Students will be required to use hand sanitizer OR wash their hands with soap and warm water upon entering the building
7. Once inside the class area, dancers will find their own individual dance space marked with tape or a hula hoop (depending on the venue). This will help dancers maintain social distancing during classes.
8. If the building allows, we will have separate entrance and exit doors. Please watch for the signs when you arrive. This will vary between venues.
9. The dancing area, bathrooms, lobby and all surfaces will be cleaned/sanitized between age groups, as well as periodically throughout the night.
10. The kitchen area will be closed until further notice. Please send meals that can be eaten cold.
11. Please note that teachers are not responsible for dancers outside of class time. If your child does not take all dance styles and has a break between classes please make sure he/she sits quietly with a book or game in the lobby.
12. Lastly, teachers will be provided masks to wear if/when they need to be close to the students. They will not wear masks while teaching, but they will maintain social distance. Masks are optional for students.

**\*\*Please review these guidelines with your dancer beforehand so things go smoothly upon arrival. We want students to be prepared and aware of the new protocols. Please arrive early so dancers can wash/sanitize before class begins.**
